Krugerrands are ounce-denominated gold bullion coins designed for investors around the world who wish to own gold.

Krugerrands are the world's most widely held gold bullion coins. More Krugerrands (46m ounces) have been circulated worldwide than all other gold bullion coins combined.

Krugerrands are available in four sizes – containing exactly 1 oz, 1/2 oz, 1/4 oz or 1/10 oz of pure gold. Krugerrands are alloyed with a small amount of copper, making them 22 carat coins – containing, therefore, 11/12 24 carat gold and 1/12 copper. Copper is a traditional alloy of gold coins designed to be handled as currency. It is used to harden coins, making them more sturdy and durable.



Important features

World's first bullion coin

The Krugerrand was the first gold coin to be denominated in ounces of pure gold; the mass-produced 1 oz gold bullion coin in 1970, the fractionals (1/2 oz, 1/4 oz and 1/10 oz) in 1980. The Krugerrand name is known to millions of people around the world.

Traded Internationally

Krugerrands can be bought from, or sold to, thousands of coin dealers and banks and their branches worldwide. As the Krugerrand is so well recognized, buying and selling Krugerrands internationally is easy.

Traded for their gold content

Krugerrands carry only a small premium (mark-up) over the value of their gold content – unlike collector or numismatic coins where the value is normally dependent on their rarity and condition. Krugerrands are designed for gold investors.

Value easily monitored

As the gold price is quoted internationally in terms of troy ounces, the value of Krugerrands (which contain exactly 1 oz, 1/2 oz, 1/4 oz or 1/10 oz of pure gold) can easily be determined at any time.

Legal Tender Coin

Krugerrands have always been legal tender coins under South African legislation. They are minted by the South African Mint. As legal tender coins, they do not need to be assayed or melted down upon resale – unlike many cast and minted gold bars.

Durable

Krugerrands are sturdy. As their gold purity is 22 carat, they are hard enough to resist normal scratching and denting – an important, practical feature, as soft 24 carat coins and bars are more easily damaged and generally require protective packaging.

Portable

Krugerrands are easy to transport and store.

Issued by the world's largest gold producing country South African gold mines have been the most important source of gold for the international gold market over the past 80 years.



Minted in South Africa

Krugerrands are minted by the South African Mint from gold coin blanks supplied by Rand Refinery Limited.

The South African Reserve Bank has authorised Rand Refinery Limited, the world's largest gold refinery, as the sole entity to sell Krugerrands from source to primary distributors worldwide.
